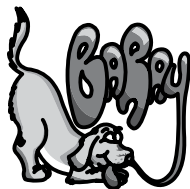

SPECIAL NOTICE – SPECIALTY CLUBS OBEDIENCE TRIALS & RALLY TRIALS

August 21-22, 2009

With the approval of the American Kennel Club, Obedience Trial classes and Rally Trial classes for the participating Specialty Clubs each day will be consolidated to provide maximum efficiency in scheduling and judging. The Judging Program for each day will include a complete list of breeds to be judged, and the order in which they will be judged. All Specialty Clubs that are offering Obedience Classes and/or Rally Classes each day will be judged together. Each dog will be judged and individual scores recorded in the respective breed’s judge’s book. For the group exercises in Obedience, all breeds will be judged in one group. If there are more dogs competing than can be spaced four (4) feet per dog on one side of a ring, some must be judged in another group. The judge will divide the class into equal sections and the group exercise will be judged after each section. Following completion of group exercises, the judge will complete the judge’s books for all dogs entered in each Obedience class in the respective breed’s judge’s book. Ribbons and awards will then be awarded by breed. Group Clubs are not considered to be Specialty Clubs and will be judged separately from the Specialty Clubs each day. Qualifying points in Obedience are based on the number of dogs in each breed only.

Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veteran Classes.

Field Trial Dog Class Field Trial Bitch Class

A class for dogs and a class for bitches that have placed in a Regular Derby, Gundog, or an All Age Stake at a licensed AKC Field Trial. Exhibitor must attach verification to the entry form (trial name, date, class and placement). Puppy stakes do not count.

Versatility/Hunting Dog Class Versatility/Hunting Bitch Class

A class for dogs and a class for bitches that has attained his/her Versatility or Versatility Excellent Certificate, or Junior, Senior or Master Hunter titles. (A photocopy of the Versatility Certificate must be attached to entry.)

Winners of the above Non-Regular classes, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible to compete in Best of Breed.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION: The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owner's records.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries)

Note: As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.

Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dogs and no less than two nor more than four of their Get. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. The owner of the stud dog need not necessarily be owner of the get. While the merits of the stud dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the stud dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular class.

Brood Bitch Class: For Brood Bitches and no less than two nor more than four of their Produce. Brood Bitch must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. The owner of the brood bitch need not necessarily be owner of the produce. While the merits of the brood bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the brood bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed. Produce must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular class.

Brace Class: Two dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one common owner. Dogs do not need to be entered in any other class. This class will require a fee of \$17.00 as a unit. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class only." An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class."

AWARD OF MERIT

At the conclusion of Best of Breed, after picking Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, the Judge, at his/her discretion, may choose up to two of the Best of Breed entry for an Award of Merit. Winners Dog and Winners Bitch shall not be eligible for the Award. The Award of Merit shall be a Rosette.

BEST PUPPY IN THE REGULAR CLASSES

The first place winner of each of the four puppy classes will compete for Best Puppy. The 12 months and under 18 months classes are not considered a puppy class.

In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Only fee applies.
